At the end of a job, focus on your financial, mental, and physical wellbeing. There are a number of programs, supports and resources designed to help you through a retrenchment or job loss. It is never easy when you find out you have lost your job. There are many things going through your mind, and the goal to secure a new job is front and centre. Here's a range of local contacts and programs to support you and your family at this time.

Local Jobs Program

The Local Jobs Program is an Australian Government initiative operating in 51 regions across Australia to maximise employment outcomes in local communities. The North West Country Employment Facilitator, Andrea Broadfoot, is based in Port Lincoln and covers the North West Country - Port Augusta, Whyalla and Port Lincoln Regions, providing support to connect people who have been retrenched or lost their job to a range of Government programs, services and supports. We have extensive connections across the region with employers and service providers, and services are free and confidential.

Workforce Australia

The Australian Government supports retrenched workers and their partners to find new employment through Workforce Australia, regardless if eligible for income support or not. Retrenched workers and their partners will be Fully Eligible Participants for employment services under the Early Access initiative.

Retrenched workers (and their partners) can register for Early Access through a Workforce Australia Employment Services Provider even if not eligible for income support.

You can access Workforce Australia and its online features, through your <u>myGov account</u> and have it linked to Workforce Australia to receive employment services support. The level of support you receive is tailored to your circumstances. It can include help with your job search, assistance with job applications and interview techniques. The Redundancy Information Statement (RIS) is a resource designed to help educate workers about all of their rights and entitlements in the event they are retrenched.

The RIS includes information on redundancy pay, notice periods and financial entitlements. It also outlines support services you can access if you have been made redundant, such as help finding a new job, financial advice, and looking after your health and wellbeing.

Financial Information Service

Services Australia delivers the Financial Information Service. Talking to a FIS Officer at a time when employees are facing retrenchment is always a good idea. As part of their conversation, the FIS Officer will explain how lump sum payments affect different Centrelink payments and entitlements.

The Financial Information Service runs its own phone queue, so that it's quick and simple to get in touch with them. Anyone can ring to speak to a FIS Officer by calling Services Australia on 132 300. When the IVR system asks why they are calling, callers should say "Financial Information Service".
